



What is JA in a Day (JAIAD) OR Traditional? This is an amazing program offered to K-5 schools. JA volunteers take over a classroom to teach financial literacy, work readiness and entrepreneurship classes to K-5 students.

JA Day – All taught in 1 day.

JA Traditional –2- 5 lessons (typically 50 minutes each) taught on multiple days. Scheduled as listed below.

As a volunteer, we ensure you are prepared with all materials and training. At the end of the course, the students will have completed five JA lessons and will have earned their JA certificate. Teachers help lead the class and the JA volunteer will teach virtually through a link the educator will share in advance.
