LRTA Returns to Bossier City for Fall Meeting

(Baton Rouge, La.)- The Louisiana Retired Teachers Association returns to Bossier City to host its annual fall meeting from October 24-26. This year's meeting, "Back in the Saddle, Again," will be held at the Hilton Garden Inn located on 2015 Old Minden Rd.

The fall meeting serves as an opportunity for retired educators around the state to connect with one another. "Back in the Saddle, Again" will be the first in-person fall meeting LRTA has held since the COVID-19 pandemic.
