2013 Regular Legislative Session Update—Final June 7, 2013

Provided below is a list of resolutions that passed the legislature during the 2013 Regular Legislative Session. All other pieces of legislation that was being monitored by LRTA did not pass. Since none of the bills passed, this will be the final LRTA Legislative Update.

House Concurrent Resolution No. 2 by Representative Joseph A. Harrison

This resolution suspends for one year the provisions of law regarding the implementation of the cash balance plan.

LRTA supports the resolution.

This resolution was passed by the House Retirement Committee on April 25, 2013. Passed the House of Representatives on May 6, 2013. Passed by the Senate Retirement Committee on May 13, 2013. Passed by the Senate on May 22, 2013.

House Concurrent Resolution No. 40 by Representative Joseph Harrison and Senator Barrow Peacock

This resolution memorializes the U. S. Congress to consider reducing or repealing the Government Pension Offset and the Windfall Elimination Provision affecting the payment of Social Security benefits.

LRTA supports the resolution.

This resolution was passed by the House of Representatives on April 9, 2013, and passed by the Senate on April 15, 2013.
